Get out of the house with baby and meet up and socialise with other parents and carers

Park buggies safely in the foyer or at the back of the auditorium (space permitting)



Bring in car baby seats



Change nappies in our auditorium Nappy Changing area



Warm milk or baby food in our microwave



Bring babies up to 12 months old to all the films, and up to 18 months where the film certificate is U, PG or 12A



Safely keep an eye on baby and move around the auditorium in our slightly brighter auditorium lighting for these special screenings



Not worry if baby cries or screams!

Officially launched at the *Baby & Toddler Show* at the Winter Gardens in Weston-super-Mare later this month, General Manager Jon Webber said of the new film club, "We have already received some tremendous feedback on this new initiative, and we are positive it will be a screaming success. So many young parents and carers miss out on seeing all the latest film releases because of their childcare responsibilities. This is the chance to get to see films as they are released without having to arrange for a babysitter. And there is a social side to the film club too. Parents can meet up with other parents at the cinema before the film starts and share a cup of coffee whilst swapping baby stories."

The new film club will run on Wednesday mornings throughout term time, with the film starting at 11.00am. Doors open at 10.00am, so there's time to socialise before the film starts. The first film club screening is on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2004 with the performance of *The Bourne Supremacy* (Cert. 12A) starring Matt Damon.

The upper age limit for babies is 12 months, but for films with a U, PG or 12A Certificate the upper age limit is 18 months. Membership is free and those wanting to join can just turn up on the day, or they can pre-register by visiting the Curzon's web site ([www.curzon.org.uk](http://www.curzon.org.uk)). Adults will not be allowed admission without an accompanying baby.
